Welcome to the “DBC 200 Club”

If you didn't already know, Duxford has its very own local lottery – the “DBC 200 Club”. So how does the “DBC 200 Club” work, and what do I have to do to become a member?

It really couldn't be easier. You pay £12 for a one-off annual membership, we give you a membership card with your unique number and then all you have to do is wait until your number comes up. The frequency of prize draws is shown over the page, and in total there are no fewer than 18 opportunities to win cash prizes ranging from £10 to £100. Provided you are over 16 years of age you can buy as many “DBC 200 Club” numbers as you like, and once you have bought one there is nothing to stop you giving it to someone who is under 16.

Who will benefit from “DBC 200 Club” profits?

Duxford Bowls Club is sponsoring the “DBC 200 Club”, and all the profit it makes will help to run the bowls club, maintain its bowling and club-house facilities and preserve this important village amenity for everyone to enjoy for years to come. (In 2022 it raised almost £500!)

“DBC 200 Club” Membership Rules

1. The “DBC 200 Club” is a small society lottery registered for operation by **Duxford Bowls Club**, under The Gambling Act 2005, licence number SL257593. The Promoter is Peter Dixon, Treasurer for Duxford Bowls Club.
2. Annual membership of the “DBC 200 Club” is gained by the payment of a single sum of £12, thereby entitling the member to participation in periodic prize draws. The draw frequency and prizes (based on 100 members) are as follows:-

| 1st Prize | £40 | £40 | £40 | £40 | £40 | £100 |
| 2nd Prize | £25 | £25 | £25 | £25 | £25 | £50 |
| 3rd Prize | £10 | £10 | £10 | £10 | £10 | £25 |

3. The maximum permitted membership is two hundred. **(In 2022 the membership failed to reach this level, and so prizes have been scaled down, broadly in proportion to the shortfall.)**
4. Membership will commence from Monday 22nd May 2023, by which time the membership fee must be paid in full. The first prize draw will be made between this date and the 31st May 2023, with subsequent draws being made in the months shown above.
5. Prize draws will be made in a public place in view of at least six persons.
6. Each member will have an equal chance of winning each prize. For example, a member who wins a 1st prize will have an equal chance of winning a 2nd and 3rd prize with the same number.
7. Prize winners’ names will be announced in the Duxford Chatterbox as soon as practicable and winners’ payments will be made as soon as possible after each draw is made.
8. There is no limit to the number of tickets that can be held by any individual.
9. Tickets cannot be purchased by persons below 16 years of age, though membership can be assigned to such persons by those over the age of 16 years.
10. No refunds of monies paid for tickets can be made under any circumstances.
11. It will not normally be possible to allocate specific membership numbers on demand, though every effort will be made to do so.
12. In any dispute the decision of the Promoter will be final.
